CONTINUED COMMITMENT

As mentioned above, Mountview Baptist sent a team of people to work with us in June. It would have been easy for some groups to come and make an impact and then walk away, but this church is different. The people at Mountview are committed to seeing what God is doing in our neighborhood, and God is blessing their devotion.

Here is a very brief summary of two years working together: Two years ago the leaders of the youth group were looking for a local mission trip. They brought a group of teens to stay with us for a week, one of whom decided to become a weekly volunteer. And then a friend started coming every week, and then her dad joined them. And then another teen friend came with the group. A couple of the regular volunteers became mentors to some of our inner city youth. And because of the existing connection, the church's small groups started looking for ways to volunteer for special work days and so more got involved. Because of how God is moving, the pastor began a scripture series on "the least of these" and invited us to come and speak. And, most recently, when unrest and violence in Thailand forced them to cancel their trip overseas, they chose to minister with us locally instead!

As a result of their time teaching some of our kids this June, they asked if they could take a few kids to the church's week-long summer camp. So three of UC's elementary kids went to northern Ohio for a week with some youth from Mountview. While there, two got baptized (with parental permission and checking to make sure they understood and didn't feel pressure) and one recommitted her already existing decision for Christ. They had so much fun that they wanted other kids to go, so two weeks later four of our middle schoolers went to camp with a pastor and youth from Mountview. During their week those four also expressed desire to be baptized and got to do that at camp! I'm happy to say it's on video for the parents to see so they can participate in this part of the kids' lives.

God is using the faithfulness of the people at Mountview is having an impact on our neighborhood. If any one person in a long chain had simply said "no, thank you", many lives would be sadly lacking. We are glad they haven't walked away and blessed to call them our partners.
