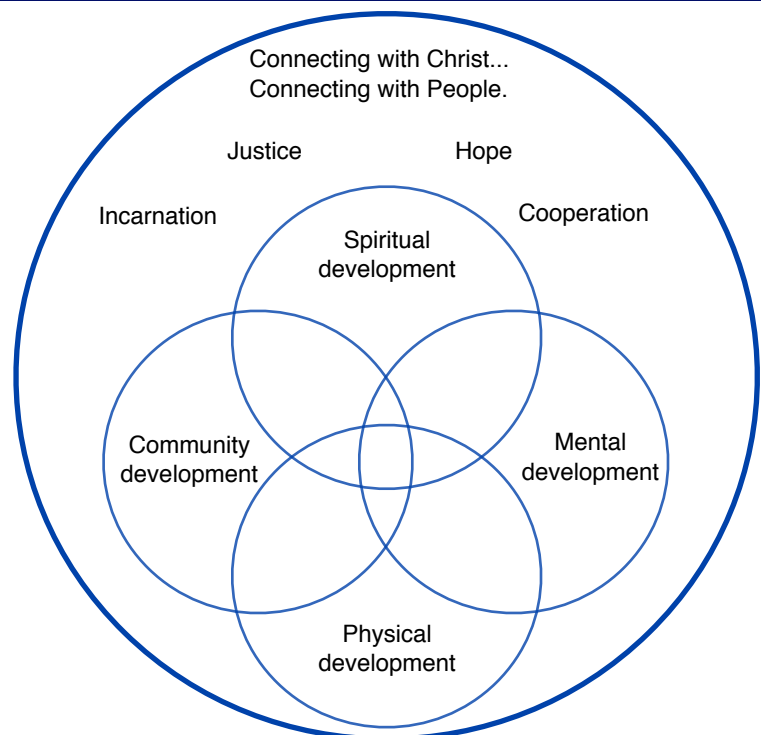
INTERNET SEARCHING
